The Dugdale Society was founded in 1920 to promote and foster the study of Warwickshire history, by publishing records relating to the county.

When you join the Society you will be contributing to new advances in the history of Warwickshire. Named after the county's greatest historian, Sir William Dugdale, the society welcomes new members. You receive for your subscription each of the series of hardback books making up a library of documents which throw light on Warwickshire's past. The society provides high quality sources which are used by historians locally, and by scholars in this country and overseas. You will add to your own enjoyment of local history, and you will help to make the county better known throughout the world.

As a member of the Society, in addition to receiving a copy of each volume of documents as it appears, you can buy copies of the Society's past publications at a discount. You will be invited each year to an annual meeting at which leading historians give papers on new discoveries about the history of Warwickshire, and you will receive a printed version of each paper when it becomes available. You will also be invited to a summer meeting in a historic house. These occasions give you chances to meet informally with others interested in history.

## SUBSCRIPTIONS

Members pay an annual subscription, in advance, on 1st January each year. Subscription rates are decided upon by the members at an Annual General Meeting; personal members in the UK currently pay £20 per annum. Oversea rates and those for libraries and institutions are supplied upon request.
